External Extraction Possible		• Check atmosphere • Check ventilation is working • Perform external extraction • Call 1st aid & 000 • Advise Site Office/Reception & Project Manager where to send emergency services
External Extraction NOT Possible	X	• Call Rescue & 1st Aid by radio or phone • Re-check atmosphere • Check ventilation is working • Standby person to brief Rescue & 1st Aid personnel of situation • Rescue entrant to don harness, spreader bar and BA if required. • Standby person to attach rescue winch or pulley to the rescuers harness • 1st aider to call 000, Site Office/Reception and Project Manager, advising them of the situation and what location (If the 1st aider has not arrived then the Standby person will start to make these calls) • Advise other standbys operating permits under rescue personnels control to remove their entrants. • Standby person and 1st aider to assist rescue personnel with entering the confined space • Rescuer to find entrant and assess his condition • Attach spreader bar and winch / pulley to entrants' harness • Instruct Standby person to start operating the winch under guidance from Rescue • Once entrant is out, 1st Aid Officer to administer CPR/First aid if necessary
